DID YOU KNOW?

Mrs. Glenn James was named the "Florida Church Woman of the Year" at the annual convention of United Church Women of Florida held in Sarasota the week of May 7th. She was chosen for this honor because of her work for the ecumenical church membership throughout the state.

Miss Elizabeth Jean Mayo, daughter of Mr. William T. Mayo, won the \$2,000.00 scholarship to the University of Miami from the State Junior Chamber of Commerce "My True Sincerety" essay contest. She was also named winner of one of the Duke University's Angler B. Duke Memorial Scholarships in late April.

Prof. Raymond K. Sheline (Chemistry and Physics Dept. of FSU) with two co-researchers has discovered a new family of football-shaped nuclei-the center part of atoms-a discovery likely to lead to finding many additional nuclei.

John P. Nelson (former member of Trinity, and with the Institute of Governmental Research at FSU) has been appointed by Gov. Farris Bryant to coordinate the work of state, local, and federal governments to provide public services in the mushrooming Cape Canaveral area. Nelson has opened an office in Cocoa and they have joined the Methodist Church there.

Prof. J. Stanley Marshall (Science Education Dept. of FSU) recently told delegates at the National Science Teacher Assn. meeting in San Francisco that "some educators show poor taste in arguing that scientists shouldn't write the new science courses because they haven't studied educational psychology. It may be that our formal studies in these fields have not really taught us very much.

Prof. R. W. Menzel (Oceanographic Institute of FSU) earned a Salt Water Conservative Award, sponsored by the Sears Foundation under auspices of the Florida Wildlife Federation, for research on clams, and assisting advances in personnel training.
