


## **Book 3 Explanation**

1899-1909

Book 3 is presented in a vertical format. It measures ten inches by fourteen inches and is one and an eight-inch thick. The pages are all in good condition and intact with the binding. This is the only membership book at Trinity which has the unique embossing of M. E, Church, South. The contents of this membership book are explained by the personal entries of two ministers. Close examination of the databases will aid the user in understanding why the preachers-in-charge made their statements.







## Handwritten--

This register begins with the pastorate of Rev. W.J. Carpenter Dec 20, 1899. The old records are preserved in a book which is a part of the Parsonage Library and which may be found among the books. A part of the data of the last year of J.B. Ley's pastorate were lost. It is hoped that this book will be "faithfully kept."
