with an overcoat on.

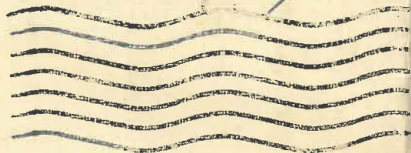
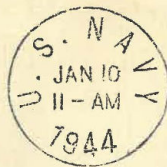
I am hoping to have
