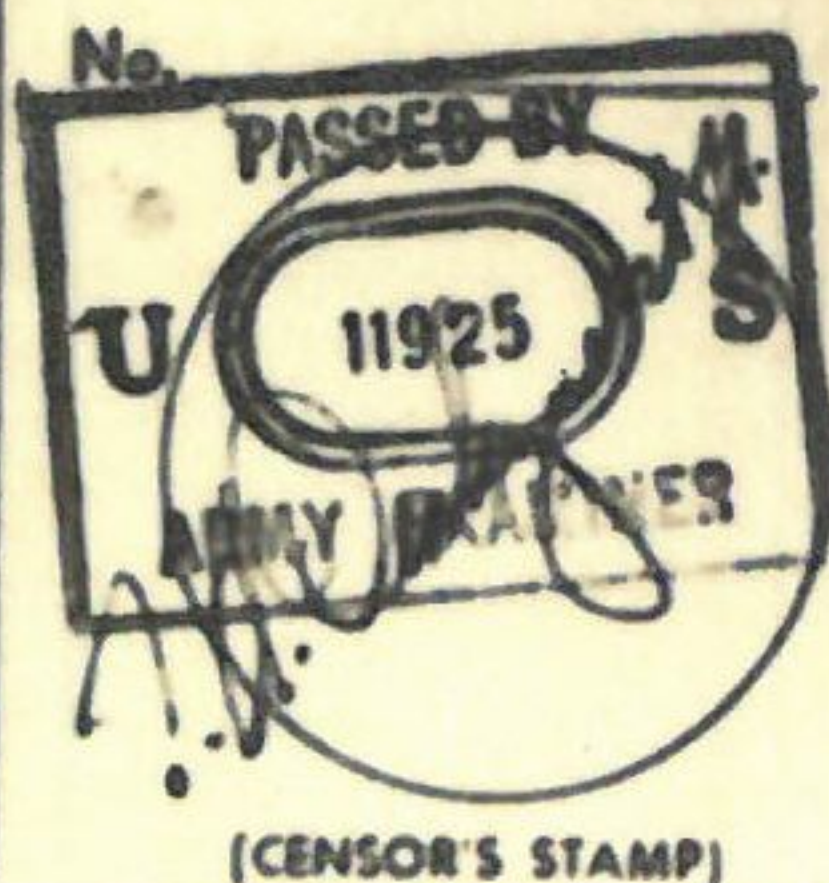

I have received your letter that was written on July 3rd notifying me of my membership in the Trinity Methodist Church of Tallahassee, and I am very proud to be a member of your church.

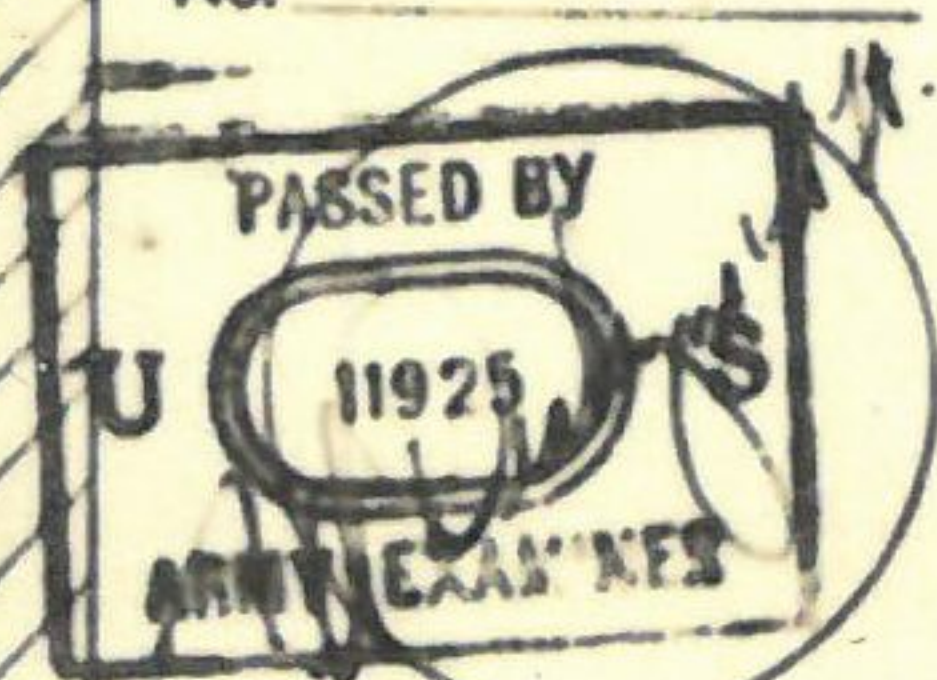
